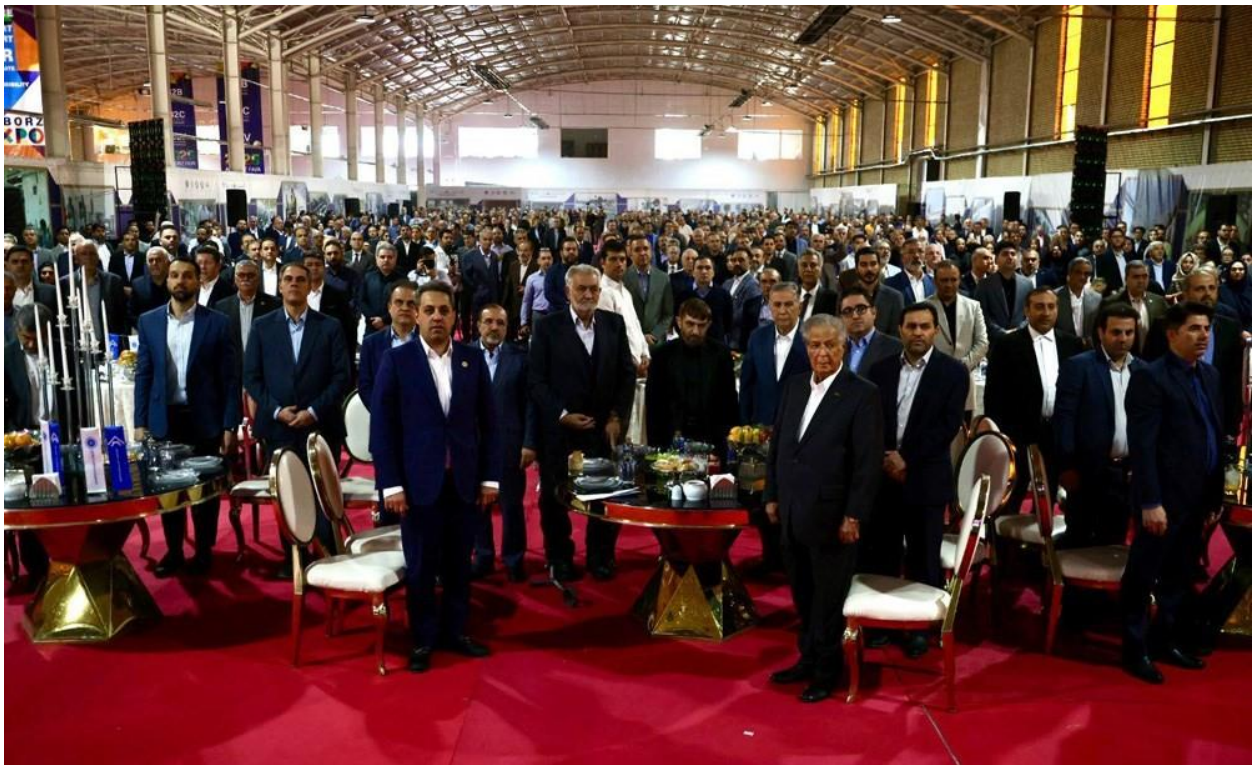




Ceremony to celebrate production and exports in Alborz Province
